- The study also revealed that there was no significant relationship between adjustment and school environment of IX standard students.

- The result of the present study revealed that their was no significant between adjustment of Boys and Girls.
- The Girls have more adjustment than the Boys.
- The private unaided school students have more adjustment than the private aided and Government school students.

CONCLUSIONS

Though there was a significant relationship between adjustment of IX standard students and Home environment, there is no significant relationship was found between adjustment of IX standard student and control of Home environment. Differences in Home Gender, had no impact on adjustment of students of IX standard students. Types of school in which IX standard students are studying had its impact on their adjustment.

The students studying in private unaided schools are adjusted better than the students studying private aided schools and Government schools. The private unaided are started to meet the educational needs of all sections of the society, students studying in these schools generally come across with the students of varied intellectual abilities, social-economic status, different gender, religion and caste. The students to be more adjusted than the of private aided and Government schools. Flexibility in the following the rules and regulations, adoptive of innovative methods of teaching in curriculum for of teachers for the educational progress of students etc, must be enforce so as to make students of private aide and unaided schools adjusted.
